



Be A Part Of Disability Mentoring Day October 15th

On Wednesday, October 15, Flagler County students will be participating in Disability Mentoring Day, a nationally coordinated job shadowing opportunity that provides young people with disabilities the opportunity to see the day-to-day responsibilities required of a person in their field of career interest.

The students, who have volunteered to participate in this program, will be paired with a worksite mentor who will spend the morning with the student sharing the highlights of their career and workplace.

The time commitment will be from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon. Prior to the mentoring day, students will receive coaching in presenting themselves professionally. They will practice appropriate questions to ask and they will create a resume. The overwhelming majority of the participants are fully independent, but, if necessary, students will be accompanied by a volunteer assistant.
