



Dear Parent or Guardian:

It is the goal of Flagler Schools to ensure that all students are provided with the appropriate tools for academic/behavior and life-long success. We are able to do this through a **Multi-Tiered System of Supports** (MTSS).

Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) is an approach in Florida schools that is required in accordance with state Rule 6A-6.0331 in support of struggling students. It allows for additional instructional/behavioral support using interventions that can be adjusted based on student progress. MTSS is NOT special education but a preventative measure to ensure all students remain on track towards college and career readiness. The MTSS process consists of three levels of instruction that build on one another. The intensity of instruction increases with each tier as indicated below:

- **Tier 1** is the high-quality instruction provided to **all** students in general education classrooms.
- **Tier 2** provides additional instruction targeted to meet the needs of **some** students requiring additional instructional/behavioral support.
- **Tier 3** includes intensive interventions to meet the needs of **individual** students.

Based on recent data analysis, it has been determined that your child is in need of Tier 2 or 3 instructional/behavioral interventions targeting their Reading, Math and/or behavioral deficits. Your child's progress towards grade level benchmark expectations will be monitored throughout the MTSS process. Every effort will be made to keep you informed regarding your child's progress. We welcome your support in the problem solving process to determine how to best meet your child's needs on a daily basis.
